Huddle time: 20:00 pm 12/15/21

After reviewing the vital signs that are notable for fever, tachycardia and persistent hypotension despite fluid boluses, performing a clinical exam, and reviewing the past medical history of this patient, I have considered the signs/ symptoms of sepsis as within the differential diagnosis of this patient's presentation.

At this time, I feel that sepsis is possible or likely. Therefore, IVF have been ordered for (hypovolemia, dehydration, hypotension) as well as IV antibiotics (Ceftriaxone).

- has met criteria for a sepsis evaluation at this time based on the following criteria:

- **Trigger vitals**

- **Temp: 39.8C, HR 157, BP 124/61, RR 28, O2 94%**

CRITERIA MET:

- abnormal temperature AND abnormal HR
- suspected or documented infection Pneumonia
- high risk group: none
- signs of poor perfusion: none
- abnormalRR 13 - 18 y: ≥ 18
