¹SSC guidelines recommend systematic screening for timely recognition of sepsis. A screen coupled with sequential clinician assessment can improve specificity and timeliness of treatment. SSC guidelines also recommend implementing a protocol or guideline for management of children with sepsis, (Weiss et al, 2020)

³SSC guidelines recommend starting antimicrobial therapy as soon as possible, within one hour for septic shock and within three hours for sepsis without shock (Weiss et al, 2020).



²SSC guidelines recommend administering up to 40-60 mL/kg crystalloid fluid within 60 minutes of recognition, titrated to clinical markers of cardiac output (Weiss et al, 2020).
